

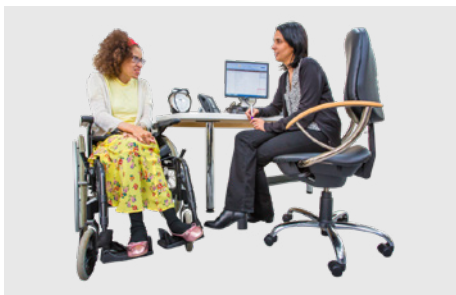

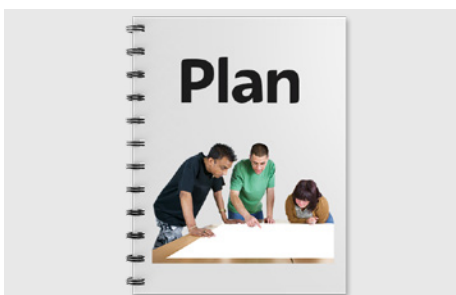
A lot of health care workers do not have the skills to support people with intellectual disability.

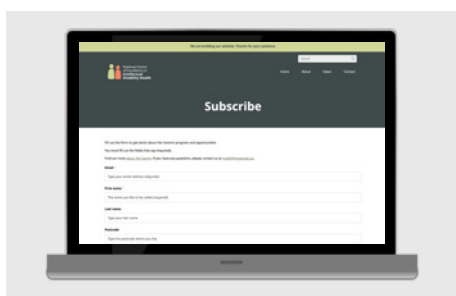
