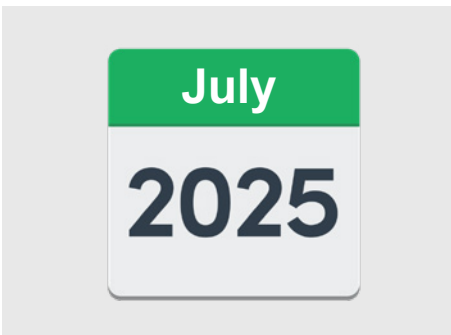

## Conference scholarships

A **conference scholarship** means we will help pay for you to go to the conference.



You can ask for a conference scholarship if you are a person with intellectual disability.



You can also ask if you are a family member or supporter.

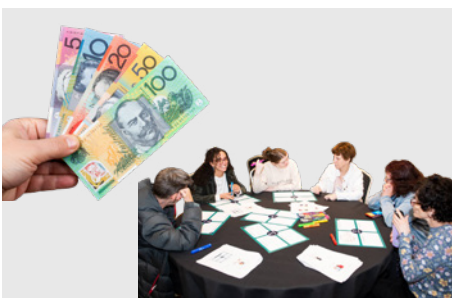


There are 2 types of conference scholarships you can ask for.

They are

1. **Registration scholarship**

2. **Travel and accommodation scholarship.**



The **registration scholarship** helps pay for your ticket to the conference.



The **travel and accommodation scholarship** helps pay for your travel and where you stay.

This means things like



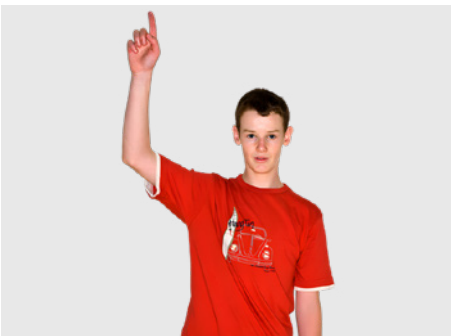
- Flights



- Taxis



- Hotels.



You can ask for 1 of the scholarships or both.



We will try to give conference scholarships to as many people as we can.

We will give the scholarships first to people with intellectual disability who



- Do not have enough money to pay for the conference



- Are First Nations



- Live in places far away from the city



- **Communicate** in ways that are not talking



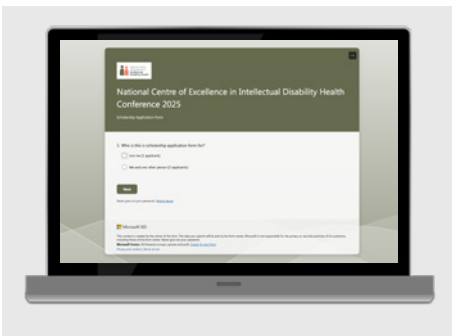
- Are from different **cultures**.



**Communicate** means how you talk to others like with a computer.

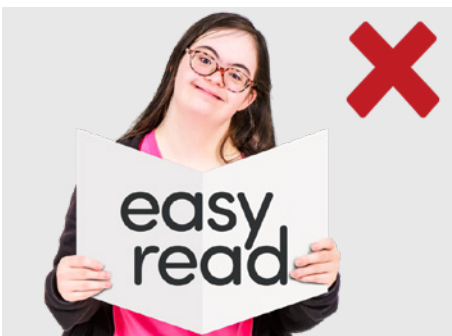


**Culture** means the way you do things because of where you or your family are from.
