

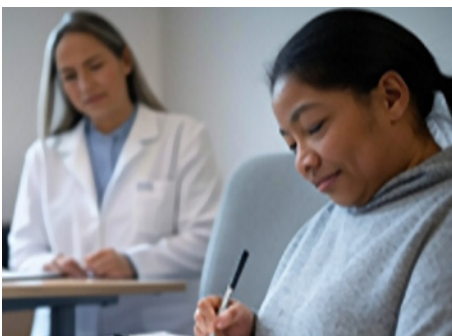
## People with intellectual disability in clinical trials

We are doing a project to find out when people with intellectual disability are left out of trials.



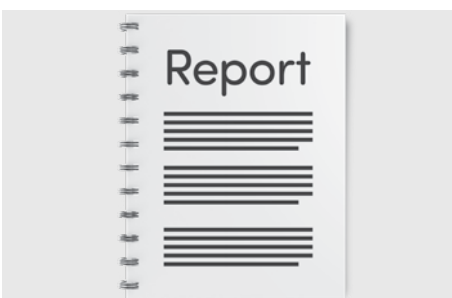
We will look at the **eligibility** for clinical trials that have happened lately in Australia.



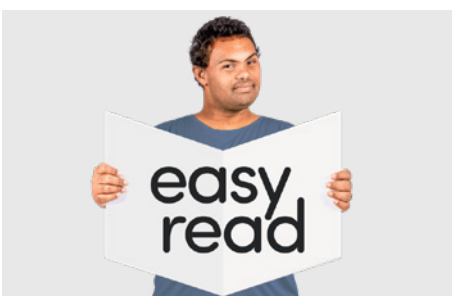
**Eligibility** means the rules for who can and can not be in the clinical trial.
