What we are doing in the project

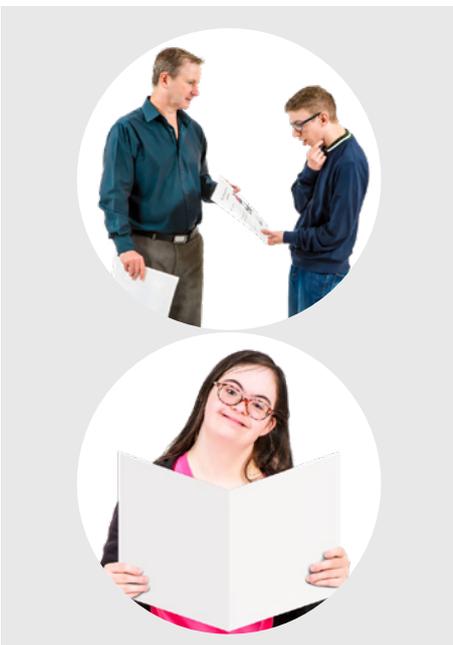


We will speak to people with intellectual disability from diverse communities.

- Health and disability staff.

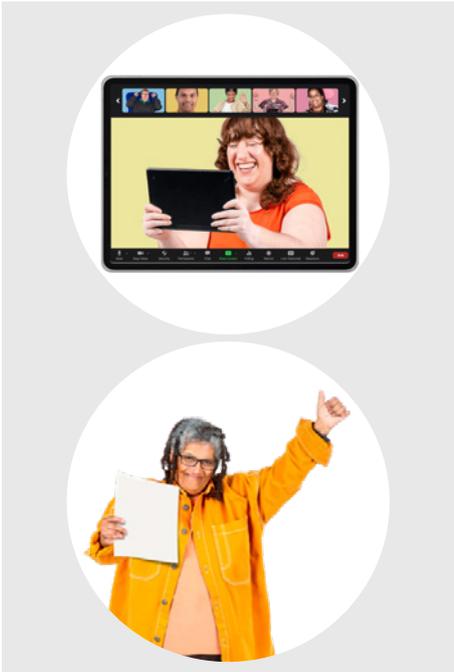


We will ask them

- Information sheets.



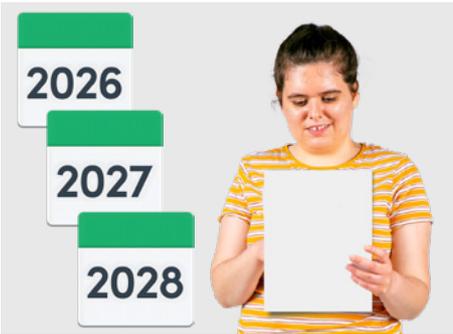
We will ask people with intellectual disability to check the information we make.



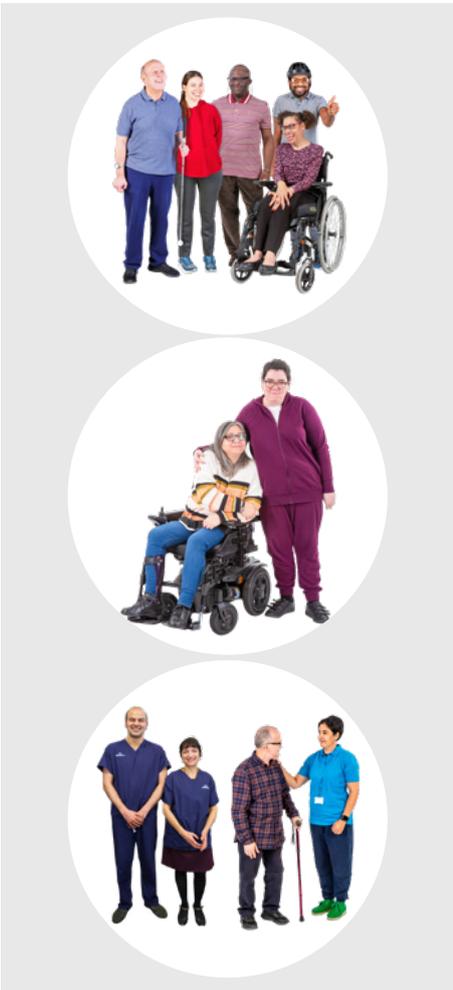
We will make a list of what people tell us makes information easy to use.
