How to get to the conference



The Sydney Masonic Centre is in the Sydney city.




You can use public transport to get there.



If you catch a train you can get off at Museum Station.



It takes about 3 minutes to get there from Museum Station.



To get there from Museum Station you can

 Find the Castlereagh Street exit and go out that way

• Turn left and go down Castlereagh Street


• When you get to Goulburn Street turn right.



You can also catch a train to Central Station to get to the conference.



It takes about 7 minutes to get there from Central Station.



When you get to Central Station you can

 Find the Elizabeth Street exit and go out that way

• Turn left and go down Elizabeth Street

• When you get to Goulburn Street turn right.



You can also catch a bus to get to the conference.



There are lots of buses that stop on Elizabeth Street and Castlereagh Street.



They stop close to the Sydney Masonic Centre.



If you drive to the conference there is no parking at the Sydney Masonic Centre.



There are car parks close by at

World Square Car Park at
 50 Goulburn Street

Goulburn Street Car Park at
 101 Goulburn Street.



There is also street parking you can pay for in the streets around the conference.

When you get to the conference



When you get to the conference you can go through the main doors.



After you go through the main doors you will see the **registration desk**.



A **registration desk** is where you go to sign in to the conference.



The workers at the registration desk will find your name tag.



After you have a name tag you can take the lift to Level 1.

• The Orange Room


• The Purple Room.

Live captions means there are words on the screen that show what people say.



There are **accessible** toilets on all of the floors.



Accessible means all people with disability can use them.
