This form is for people with intellectual disability.

This sheet has information about research called ‘Living with dementia: Experiences of people with intellectual disability and their supporters’.

Research means finding out what people think about things and using the information to help other people.

We are doing this research to understand the experiences of people with intellectual disability living with **dementia**.

Dementia is a health problem. It is caused by changes in the brain.

You can ask someone you trust to help you understand this sheet.

Who is doing the research? What is it about?

We want to find out about the experiences of people with intellectual disability living with dementia.



We want to find out the support that people with intellectual disability living with dementia want and need.

What does taking part involve?



Screening questions

We will ask you some questions to check if you can take part in the research.

We will ask you the questions over the phone.



If you cannot take part in the research we will destroy any information collected about you.



If you can take part in the research we will find a day and time for an interview.



Interview

Taking part involves answering some questions.

The interview can be

- in person



- on the phone



- or online.



We will ask you about:

- What you do during the week
- What helps you do the things you want or need to do
- What makes it hard to do the things you want or need to do.



We will send you the questions to look at before the interview.



You can choose which questions to answer.

You can say no if you don't want to answer a question.



We will ask to record what you say. If you don't want us to, that is OK. We will take notes instead.



The research will take up to 1 hour.



If you want to meet in person we will meet you at a place you choose. It could be

- A private room at the National Centre of Excellence in Intellectual Disability Health in Randwick, NSW



Or

- Your home.



If you want to, you can bring someone you trust to help you.



We will contact you again about one month after the interview.

We will check if you are happy with what you said in the interview.



You will get a \$100 gift card to say thank you.

Do I have to take part?



You only have to take part if you want to.

You can say no. It's your choice. No one will be angry if you say no.

Even if you say yes, you can change your mind later and stop taking part.

What will happen to my information?



We will store your information at the National Centre of Excellence in Intellectual Disability Health for at least 5 years.

We will keep your information private.

We will not tell anybody your name or where you live.

No one will know it was you who took part.



We will write about what we find out. If you want, we will send you a summary.
